

## National Health Fair 2026

The National Health Fair 2026 was organized by the Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India, through the All India Ayurveda Mahasammelan at Sant Gajanan Maharaj Sansthan, Shegaon from 25th to 28th February 2026.

Dr. Sangeeta Sawant, Assistant Professor (Kayachikitsa), attended as the Nodal Officer, along with PG Scholars Dr. Chetan Patil, Dr. Chetana Kalashetti, and Dr. Priyanka Mingule.

As per the schedule announced by the Ministry of AYUSH, Tilak Ayurveda College was instructed on 25th February 2026 to participate in the fair on 27th February 2026.

The team started the journey on 26th February 2026 at 7:00 PM via Sangeetam Travels and reached Visava Bhaktanivas, Sant Gajanan Maharaj Sansthan, Shegaon, at 7:00 AM on 27th February 2026.

At 8:30 AM, the entire team visited the National Health Fair venue and completed registration at 8:45 AM. After registration, the organizers provided seminar kit bags to all team members. Stall No. 13 was allotted to Tilak Ayurveda College, Pune. The college banner was displayed, and OPD patient consultations began at 9:00 AM under the guidance of Dr. Sawant and the team.

The National Health Fair included AYUSH-related stalls representing Ayurveda, Yoga & Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha, Homeopathy, and Sowa-Rigpa systems. Renowned companies such as Dhootapapeshwar, Baidyanath, Dabur, and Divine Ayurveda also set up stalls providing information about their products. An awareness lecture by Vaidya Ramdas Avhad was conducted in the adjacent hall.

At 11:00 AM, Hon. Dr. Tanuja Nesari visited the Tilak Ayurveda College stall. She was welcomed with a bouquet, and she appreciated the work carried out by the team.

Various dignitaries visited the stall and appreciated the arrangements. A team of doctors from CCRAS Nagpur also visited and provided free medicines to patients attending the stall.

PM, Dr. Anupam Shrivastava delivered a lecture on the importance of Yukti Vyapashraya Chikitsa and enlightened the participants.

Later, from 3:00 PM to 4:00 PM, a felicitation and award ceremony was conducted to thank all speakers and Vaidyas.

The main objective of the National Health Fair 2026 (Shegaon, Maharashtra) was to promote AYUSH healthcare systems (Ayurveda, Yoga, Unani, Siddha, and Homeopathy), provide free health check-ups and consultations, and empower rural communities through medicinal plant cultivation.
