

REPORT OF NATIONAL SEMINAR ON PHARMACOVIGILANCE & ADR REPORTING IN AYUSH SYSTEMS

National Seminar on Pharmacovigilance & ADR Reporting in AYUSH Systems was organized by Peripheral Pharmacovigilance Centre, Tilak Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, under Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi, on Tuesday **10th March 2026, from 1.30 pm to 5pm** at NIMA Hall, Tilak Ayurved Mahavidyalaya Pune.

75 participants were present for the Seminar. Specifically for PPvC all over India, Google Meet Link was created. **8 JRFs** joined via Online Mode. Practitioners, Teaching Faculty, Nursing staff, MD & Ph.D Scholars from T.A.M.V & various Ayurveda Colleges attended this Seminar Online & Offline.

Seminar started with blessings of Lord Dhanvantari. Stavan recited by Dr. Gauri Gangal Assist. Professor Dravyaguna Dept. Tilak Ayurved Mahavidyalaya Pune.

Welcome Address was given by respected Principal Dr Sangeeta Salvi. Afterwards PPvC Coordinator & HOD Dravyaguna Department Dr Apoorva Sangoram did the introduction of the Seminar. Total **10** winners in UG & PG section were declared. Cash prizes & Certificate of Achievement was given to the winners by the Dignitaries.

Dr. Huparikar gave his Presidential speech to the students, where he highlighted importance of ADR reporting in the field of Ayurveda. He gave his best wishes to PPvC Centre. Vote of Thanks for Inauguration Ceremony was done by Dr Pradnya Gathe.

After Inauguration ceremony, scientific sessions began. Introduction of the 1st Speaker was done by Dr. Gauri Gangal, Assist. Professor Dravyaguna Dept. **Dr. Dattatray Dighe Sir Coordinator CARI, CCRAS Mumbai** gave the lecture on 'ADR Reporting in AYUSH Systems- Case Studies'. He explained importance of ADR reporting in Ayurveda. He gave various insights on ADR cases reported by their Centre. What to report? How to fill the details? Clinical Pearl was suggested by him in ADR cases. Dechallenge, Rechallenge, Risks, Challenges

faced by PPvC Centres were explained in detail. What measures are necessary to increase the reporting culture was also suggested by him.


Introduction of 2nd speaker was done by Dr Vaibhavi Sabne JRF PPvC Centre, T.A.M.V. Pune. **Dr Aditi Kulkarni SLA Maharashtra** delivered the second lecture on '**Legal provisions for Objectionable & Misleading Advertisements**' she underlined all the specifications mentioned in Drug & Magic remedies Act. She explained all the sections such as Section 3 & 4 is for Drugs, Section 5 for Magic remedies, Section 8 for powers of entry, search etc. Conditions for exemption were explained in detail. Also recent problems faced due to fake advertisements was thoroughly explained. How we can try to solve this problem, how to sensitize people regarding fake advertisements etc was discussed in the lecture. She explained the work undertaken by SLA Maharashtra, Various portals such as ICSI, Ayush Suraksha Portal, GAMA portal were explained. How the government is taking action, as a medical professional what are our duties to prevent such MLA was discussed.

Introduction of 3rd speaker was conducted by Dr Pradnya Gathe, Asso. Professor. Dravyaguna Dept. T.A.M.V. Pune. Last lecture was given by **Dr Shraddha Yadav**, Professor, HOD Pharmacology, Symbiosis Medical College for women, Lavale. She explained the ADR reporting culture in Modern Medicine. Why it is extremely important to report the ADRs was highlighted. Also she explained the cases recorded at their AMC centre. She explained by taking example of various Antibiotics how the case was presented, how they recorded & reported the cases. To imbibe the reporting culture they undertook some tasks and how they successfully managed to build that habit was the take away from this lecture.

At the end Dr. Sangoram, Professor Dravyaguna Department, Tilak Ayurved Mahavidyalaya concluded the session. Vote of Thanks was given by Dr Vaibhavi Sabne.
