REPORT OF NATIONAL SEMINAR ON PHARMACOVIGILANCE & ADR IN AYURVEDA

PPvC Coordinator & HOD Dravyaguna Department **Prof. Dr. Apoorva Sangoram Madam** gave 1st lecture on 'Ayurvedic aspect of Pharmacovigillance & ADR'. Madam explained the Ayurvedic perspective of Pharmacovigilance & ADR in terms of Bheshaj Chatushka i.e Vaidya, Dravya, Paricharak & Rugna. Also she elaborated the interactions of Herb, Food & Drugs with each other with suitable examples. She also informed the reporting system of ADR in detail.

2nd session was conducted by Dr. Pradnya Gathe, Asso. Professor, Dravyaguna Dept. T.A.M.V. Pune. **Mr. Dinesh Khinvasara**, Asst. Commissioner FDA Pune delivered the second lecture on 'Misleading Advertisements- Problems & Solutions'. It has become a big challenge in front Drug Controllers. Sir underlined all the specifications mentioned in Drug & Magic remedies Act. He explained all the sections such as Section 3 & 4 is for Drugs, Section 2 (6) is for Magic drugs, Section 5 for Magic remedies, Section 8 for powers of entry, search etc. Conditions for exemption



were explained in detail. Also recent problems faced due to fake advertisements was thoroughly explained. How we can try to solve this problem, how to sensitize people regarding fake advertisements etc was discussed in the lecture.

3rd session was conducted by Dr. Sneha Kulkarni, Asso. Professor. Dravyaguna Dept. T.A.M.V. Pune. 3rd lecture was given by **Prof. Dr. Manasi Deshpande**, H.O.D. & Coordinator PPvC, B.V.D.U. College of Ayurved Pune on the topic, 'Adverse Drug Reactions- Case Studies' Madam explained the meaning of ADR in detail. Why it is extremely important to report the ADRs found in Ayurveda was highlighted. Also she gave details about the cases recorded at their PPvC centre, 4 case studies with all the details, how they should be recorded, and importance of recording the ADRS, collection of DATA, Causality Assessment was explained very well.





Students contributed Rs 150 each and products related to preparation, packaging and ļabelling were paid for through the cash pool. Additional payments were done through Department of Rasashastra.






















Report of Nirmitee 2023 (National workshop on Rachana Sharir)



6 days Advanced Research Methodology Course was organized at Tilak Ayurved Mahavidyalaya's Centre for Post Graduate Studies and Research in Ayurveda, Pune as per the guidelines of Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik, from 9th October to 14th October 23.

Total 50 participants were confirmed and registered for the course. The participants were from the Ayurved, Unani, Homeopathy and Modern medicine fraternity. Out of 50 participants 49 participants completed the Advanced Research Methodology Course.

Day 1 - 9/10/2023

- Present the research question for the topic and mention the type of research question.
- Mention the population
- · Mention the variables
- Mention the hypothesis of the selected topic

All the groups took an active participation and presented their topic.

The group activity was followed by a lunch break.

The post lunch session started with the lecture of Dr Jagannath Dixit.

Lecture 3 – Classification of study designs. Dr Dixit took a detailed interactive session explaining the classification of study designs and descriptive study designs.

Dr Dixit elaborated the difference in research done at MD/MS level and the research done at the PhD level and also explained the use of open EPI. Dr Dixit explained in details the steps to be taken in presenting the descriptive study right from how to write a research question to reporting the study and generating the hypothesis.

After the elaborative lecture, a lecture demonstration was given by Dr Jaganath Dixit by sharing two different articles in the 5 groups in which Dr Vinaya Dixit and Dr Apoorva Sangoram coordinated with all the groups and help the participants in discussing the

following points

The lecture demonstration included the following points -

- o Issues in descriptive studies
- o Research question
- o Population types
- Sampling and sample size
- o Measurements
- o Bias in descriptive studies selection bias and measurement bias
- o Ethical issues in research studies
- Analysis and hypothesis generation.

The lecture demonstration was followed by the next lecture by Dr Jagannath Dixit.

Lecture 4 – Case control studies

Dr Dixit gave a detailed explanation of case control studies.

The lecture was followed by a group activity in which the following points were discussed regarding issues in case control/cohort studies –

- Research question
- Population types
- · Sampling and sample size
- Sources and selection of cases and controls/comparison
- · Measurement of exposure
- Bias in case control studies selection, measurement, confounding matching
- Analysis, statistical testing, odds ratio, RR, AR, multivariate analysis.

After the group activity all the groups presented types of bias and measures to minimize them as per the topic selected by all the five groups. Dr Jaganath Dixit cleared all the doubts of the participants.

Feedback forms were distributed to the participants for the day one lectures and the participants filled the feedback forms and handed over to the organizers.

Day $2 - \frac{10}{10} \frac{2023}{2023}$

After the recitation of Dhanwantari stawan, the session coordinator's Dr Apoorva Sangoram and Dr Vinaya Dixit started the day 2 proceedings.

Dr Mihir Hajarnavis gave a detailed information about the salient features of MUHS PhD directions. Dr Hajarnavis explained all the rules and regulations and the directions to be

followed while completing the PhD course. He also suggested all the PhD scholars to complete their PhD course within the stipulated time.

Lecture 5 - Cohort studies.

Dr Sagar Khandagale gave an elaborative lecture on Cohort studies. Dr Khandagale explained in details about the advantages and disadvantages of Cohort studies. He also explained about Retrospective Cohort.

The lecture on Cohort studies was followed by the group activity in which all the issues were discussed by all the groups and all the group activity was guided by Dr Sagar Khandagale & Session coordinators Dr Apoorva Sangoram and Dr Vinaya Dixit.

Lecture 6 - Clinical trial

Dr Prasad Pore gave an excellent presentation on Clinical trials. It was an interactive session and all the participants actively participated and got their basics cleared.

Dr Pore explained in details the types of Clinical trials, phases of clinical trials, pre requisites of Randomized clinical trials and the steps to be followed while doing a clinical trial. He also elaborated on how to maintain the documentation of a clinical trial.

Dr Pore also explained the AYUSH GCP guidelines and their importance while doing a clinical trial.

After an elaborative lecture on clinical trials, group activity was conducted and all the groups were asked to discuss and present their respective topics on clinical trials.

The group activity was followed by a Lecture demonstration where an example of a clinical trial was taken by all the five groups and they were asked to present their topic including the following points

- Research question
- Population types
- Sampling and sample size
- · Randomization method used
- · Bias in the study
- Analysis and interpretation of the study

Feedback forms were distributed to the participants for the day two lectures and the participants filled the feedback forms and handed over to the organizers.





Day 3 - 11/10/2023

After the recitation of Dhanwantari stawan, the session co-ordinators Dr. Ashwini Bodade and Dr Asmita Jadhav started the day 3 proceedings.

Lecture 7 - Types of variables

Dr Amitav Banerjee gave a detailed explanation of types of variables, conversion of data from one type to another and scales of management. It was an interactive session.

Dr Amitav Banerjee gave a Lecture demonstration on methods of data presentation.

Dr Amitav Banerjee demonstrated how to use MS excel in preparing various types of data presentations and the participants were asked to practice using MS excel in preparing data presentations. As it was an interactive session all the participants enthusiastically did the group activity.

Lecture 8 - Intellectual property rights, Patent

Dr Mugdha Lele explained in details with excellent examples about types of property, types of intellectual property and the criteria for patent registration process till filing a patent on one's name

Lecture 9 - Regulatory aspects in research

After a short lunch break, **Dr Girish Tillu**, a very eminent researcher in the field of Ayurveda, gave a very elaborative information about regulatory aspects in research which included important topics like – CONSORT, AYUSORT and Role of FDA in research. He also gave a detailed information on publication guidelines.

Lecture 10 – Proposal writing for funding agencies. Dr Girish Tillu explained in details as to how to proceed for a protocol development and explained in details the steps to be followed in a protocol development. The informative lecture was very well appreciated by the participants and all the participants were boosted to start developing their research protocol and get it published in a good scientific journal.

Lecture 11 - Ethics in health sciences research.

Dr Surekha Shinde explained in details with various examples regarding the ethical issues in Biomedical research in India. Dr Surekha Shinde explained the basic fundamentals principles of Human research ethics, importance of consent and also informed the importance of plagiarism and methods to avoid the plagiarism in one's research study presentation. The lecture was very informative and widely appreciated by the participants.

Feedback forms were distributed to the participants for the day three lectures and the participants filled the feedback forms and handed over to the organizers.

Day 4 - 12/10/2023

After the recitation of Dhanwantari stawan, the session co-ordinators Dr. Taranoom Patel and Dr. Ashwini Bodade started the day 4 proceedings.

Lecture 12 - Literature search

Dr Kadambari Ambeldhok delivered a very informative lecture on how to do a thorough literature search using various authentic search engines like Shodh ganga, Pubmed, Medline, Mbase and Google scholar. Dr Ambeldhok explained in details how to search, read, think and critically analyze a literature search.

Group activity – Dr Kadambari Ambeldhok along with session coordinators Dr Taranoom Patel and Dr. Ashwini Bodade carried out the group activity by asking the participants to do a literature search by using the Shodh ganga software. All the groups actively participated in the group activity.

Lecture 13 - Referencing management

Dr Kadambari Ambeldhok demonstrated how to search in soft wares like Zotero, Mendely and Endnote.

She also gave a detailed information on the Cochrane library.

Both the lectures given by Dr Kadambari Ambeldhok were very informative and were very much appreciated by the participants.

Lecture 14 - Evaluation of diagnostic tests

Dr Suwarna Joshi a senior researcher from the department of biochemistry from B J Medical College gave an excellent presentation on how to evaluate diagnostic tests in one's research project. She also explained the importance of diagnostic tests, their evaluation and their standardization while doing a research project.

Dr Suwarna Joshi asked the participants to calculate the sensitivity and specificity of few diagnostic tests.

Group Activity - Research priorities in various disciplines

Dr Suwarna Joshi gave a detailed information of the top 5 research priorities in health, A brief explanation on CCRAS which is the apex body of Research in Ayurveda and how health care outbreak activities can be done to globalize the research in Ayurveda.

Lecture 15 - Questionnaire designing

Dr Surekha Shinde first informed all the sources of gaining information of a particular topic and then explained the importance of questionnaire designing in one's research project. She gave a detailed explanation with various examples as to how a good questionnaire can be designed.

Dr Surekha Shinde explained the Lickert scale in measuring the attitude of a questionnaire and how to pilot and validate a questionnaire.

Group activity – Few examples of a questionnaire were given to all the groups and the participants were asked to scale a good and a bad questionnaire. The activity was done with full enthusiasm and all the participants took an active participation in the given group activity.

Day 5 - 13/10/2023

After the recitation of Dhanwantari stawan, the session co-ordinators Dr. Mihir Hajarnavis and Dr. Minakshee Randive started the day 4 proceedings.

Group 3 presented their topic on Statistical tests. All the other groups took an active part in the interactive session and all groups appreciated the presentation done by group 3.

Lecture 16 - Inferential statistics

Dr Swati Raje delivered lecture on the topic Inferential statistics & statistical fallacies: - Parametric, non-parametric, which test to use, when & why (a case of ANOVA, also post hoc tests). She also gave a lecture demonstration on the topic Demonstration of EPI Info and Open EPI – the WHO software. The lecture was interactive.

A lecture demonstration on the topic of Sample size determination using computers was explained interactively by Dr. D.R. Basannar.

Group 5— presented their topic on Sampling methods. This group activity was conducted by Dr. D.R. Basannar along with the session coordinators Dr. Mihir Hajarnavis and Dr. Minakshee Randive.

Feedback forms were distributed to the participants for the day four lectures and the participants filled the feedback forms and handed over to the organizers.







शरीराला काहीही उपयोग होत नाही.

निदान-चिकित्सा – शरीराचे दोषधातुमल हे मूल असले तरी त्यातही शरीरातील रसादी धातुंवरच शरीर धारणाची प्रमुख जबाबदारी आहे. कोणत्याही कारणामुळे शरीरामध्ये झालेली दोषदृष्टी ही धातु व धातुघटीत अवयवांवर आक्रमण करून विकार निर्मिती करीत असते. यात दृष्ट होणारी स्त्रोतसे वा अवयव धातुघटीतच असल्या कारणाने विकार प्रक्रिया जाणून घेण्यासाठी, निदान ज्ञानासाठी व नंतर ती प्रक्रिया नाहीशी करण्यासाठी, संप्राप्ति भंग करण्यासाठी, चिकित्सेसाठी धात्विचार अपरिहार्य ठरतो

एकदा धातुसापेक्षा निदान केले की, चिकित्साही धातुसापेक्षा म्हणावयाची हे ओघानेच येते. शोधन चिकित्सा करावयाची असल्यास दोष ज्या धातुंत आले असतील त्या त्या दोषाचे शोधन करणारी वमन-विरेचन-बस्तिद्रव्ये यांची योजना करावी लागते तर शमनचिकित्सा कराययाची असेल तर तद वद धातुनुगत तत्तद दोषपाचक वा तत्तद धात्वप्रिवर्धक औषधे योजावी लागतात. अशा प्रकारे विकार प्रशमन केल्यानंतर ''रसायन'' चिकित्सा करावयाची म्हणजेच त्यांचे बृंहण – बलवर्धन करावयाचे व त्यांना पूर्वस्थितीवर आणावयाचे व पुढे क्रमाक्रमाने समप्रकृति बनवावयचे.

निष्कर्ष – रोगांचे निदान करणे जसे जटिल आहे तसेच धातुसारासार परीक्षण कठीण आहे. तरी ते अभ्यासाने साध्य आहे. प्रथमतः प्रथम एक धातु उत्तमसार व्यक्ति परीक्षणास निवडावीत, नंतर दोन धातु उत्तमसार अशा रीतीने व्यक्तींचे निरीक्षण करित राहून त्या निवडून त्यांचे परीक्षण करावे. तसेच एकधातु अल्पसार किंवा असार व्यक्ती निवडाव्या. नंतर दोन धातु, तीन धातु अल्पसार किंवा असार क्रमाने व्यक्ति निवडाव्या. समाजात अधिकाधिक धातु उत्तमसार आणि अधिकाधिक धातु असार असणारे व्यक्ति उत्तरोत्तर अत्यल्प प्रमाणात आढळतात. समाजात काही धातु उत्तमसार, काही धातु अल्पसार आणि एखाद दुसरा धातु असार अशाच व्यक्ति फार असतात.

- एकधातु उत्तमसार व्यक्ति निवडताना अस्थि धातु ज्यांना उत्तमसार आहे त्या प्रथम निवडाव्या, नंतर मज्जासार, शुक्रसार, रक्तसार, मांससार, रससार व मेदसार अशा क्रमाने व्यक्ति घ्याव्या.
- असार धातु परीक्षणात मांस, अस्थि, शुक्र, मज्जा, रक्त, मेद, रस या क्रमाने व्यक्तिंची निवड करावी.
- नंतर अधिक धातु उत्तमसार तसेच अधिक धातु असार असलेल्या व्यक्ति परीक्षणाकरिता घ्याव्या. नंतर उत्तम, मध्यम, अल्प आणि यांच्या मिश्रणाच्या व्यक्ति, त्यानंतर मध्यम अल्पसार व असार आणि शेवटी मध्यम अल्पसार व्यक्तिंचे परीक्षण करण्याची सवय करावी.
- सारासार तारतम्य ठरविण्याकरिता धातुकर्मे, धातु मलस्थिती लक्षण, प्रमाणातः व सात्म्यतः परीक्षण, गर्भोत्पादक आत्मजादी भावकार्ये, शरिरातील धातुघटीत अवयव, दीर्घायुष्य, मध्यमायुष्य, अल्पायुष्य यांची लक्षणे धातु क्षय वृद्धि लक्षणे, धातुगत विकार लक्षणे निदान चिकित्सा यांचाही उपयोग करणे उपयुक्त ठरते.

बघता बघता २०२१ सालचा मार्च महिना उजाडला आणि मधल्या काळात थंडावलेली करोना पेशंटसची संख्या पुन्हा वाढू लागली. शासनाने आखून दिलेल्या न्यू नॉर्मल गाईडलाईनचा जण्काही विसर पडल्यासारखी, सर्वसामान्य जनता नॉर्मल वागू लागली. त्यामुळे पुन्हा एकदा करोनाची द्सरी लाट येते की काय अशी परिस्थिती निर्माण झाली. एका बाजुला लसीकरण सुरु झाले आहे. फ्रंटलाईन वर्कर्स, डॉक्टर्स यांच्यानंतर साठ वर्षानंतरचे ज्येष्ठ नागरिक व ४५ ते ५० वर्षाचे, सहव्याधी असणारे नागरीक यांच्यासाठी लसीकरण शासकीय व खासगी रुग्णालयात सुरू झाले आहे. परंतु ही प्रक्रिया सुलभ होण्याऐवजी ती जास्तीत जास्त गुंतागुंतीची झाली आहे. आधी ॲपवर नोंदणी, त्यानंतर भेटीची वेळ नक्की करुनही ज्येष्ठ नागरीकांना त्या त्या नेमून दिलेल्या वेळेत लस मिळेलच असे नाही. अनेक ज्येष्ठ नागरीकांना लस मिळण्यासाठी वारंवार फेऱ्या माराव्या लागत आहेत. यासंबंधीच्या योग्य सूचना लक्षात न घेतल्यामुळे ज्येष्ठ नागरीकही सकाळी ७ वाजल्यापासून काही न खातापिता लसीकरण केंद्रावर गर्दी करायला लागले आहेत. त्यामुळे अनेक मधुमेह, रक्तदाब यासारख्या व्याधी असणाऱ्या पेशंटसना रक्तशर्करा कमी होणे, दौर्बल्य यासारखी लक्षणे जाणवायला लागली आहेत. त्यातून लसीची कमतरता ही नव्याने उद्भवणारी समस्या जाणवत आहे. कोव्हीशिल्ड की कोव्हॅक्सिन यातली कोणती लस मिळेल? एक डोस ज्या लसीचा मिळाला त्याच लसीचा दुसरा डोस मिळेल की नाही अशा अनेक शंका नागरीकांच्या मनात आहेत. त्यामुळे या सर्वांसाठीच पुन्हा नव्याने एक शिस्तबद्ध कार्यक्रम आखण्याची गरज निर्माण झाली आहे.

वाढत्या करोना रुग्णसंख्येमुळे मधल्या काळात चालू

Sanskrit Samhita Siddhant Department of Tilak Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Pune organized a National seminar on Bhashyakaar 2018 "Contribution of commentators of Charak Samhita" on 4th March 2018.

The precious knowledge of Ayurveda has been written and preserved in form of Samhita. Samhitas are the base of Ayurveda. Time to time Samhitas have been rewritten, edited and compiled and changes has been made according to evolution of mind of humans. Commentators are the bridges between ancient and modern era of samhitas. Work of commentators is an unexplored field in Ayurveda and this seminar was organized to explore the new way of thinking for better applicability of knowledge by commentators of Charak Samhita.

Seminar received a huge response from Ayurved community all over India. 170+ delegates participated in the seminar from colleges like IPGT&RA Jamnagar, Shivalik College Dehradun, Uttarakhand, Hassan College Karnataka, Ayurved College Goa, Madhya Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh and various places from Maharashtra like Mumbai, Solapur, Yavatmal, Nagpur, Nashik and Pune. Seminar was open to everyone from Ayurveda

Background-UG, PG, Practitioners and Teachers.

The idea was to explore the work of commentators on Charak Samhita. Workshop on Diagnostic measures and Local treatment methodologies in Shalakyatantra

A one day workshop on "Diagnostic measures and Local treatment methodologies in Shalakyatantra" was organized on Friday 2nd November 2018 by the Department of Shalakyatantra of Centre for Post Graduate Studies and Research in Ayurveda (C.P.G.S & R.A) of Tilak Ayurved Mahavidyalaya to celebrate the foundation day of The Association of Shalaki (TAS-India).

The basic idea of organizing the workshop was to update and upgrade the knowledge of the post graduate students of Shalakyatantra in the diagnostic measures and local treatment methodologies in Shalakyatantra and to develop confidence in them to practice Ayurvedic local treatment methodologies in various diseases in Shalakyatantra which is the need of today.

It was decided to organize the workshop in 3 sessions - (1) Diagnostic procedures (2) Local treatment procedures and (3) Guest lectures with the theme of Importance of Local treatment methodologies in Shalakyatantra and their importance in maintaining the swasthya of indriyas (sense organs).

Scientific session I -

Venue - Yoga Hall, Tarachand Hospital.

All the delegates were divided into 4 groups and there were 4 stations where different diagnostic methodologies were demonstrated. The groups were rotated to all the stations.

Scientific session II -

Venue - N.I.M.A. auditorium, T.A.M.V.

Session - Local treatment methodologies in Shalakyatantra. In this session all the treatment methodologies were demonstrated live at the NIMA auditorium.

(A) Local treatment methodologies in Netra rogas

Dr. Preeti Abhyankar, Dr. Ganesh Jadhav and Dr. Sharmila Lodhi were the Faculties for this session.

Dr. Ganesh Jadhav demonstrated all the Kriyakalpas done in Netra rogas and Dr. Preeti Abhyankar explained in details about the procedures.
