- 1) To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Tilak Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, 583/2, Rasta Peth, Pune-411011, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0141) inspection was conducted on 03.04.2025 and 04.04.2025 in hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the permission with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 57 seats in 14 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & Siddhant- 03 seats (ii) Kriya Sharir- 04 seats (iii) Dravyaguna Vigyana- 03 seats (iv) Rasa Shastra & Bhasajya Kalpana- 05 seats (v) Kaumarbhritya-Bala Roga- 02 seats (vi) Shalya Tantra-07 seats (vii) Shalaky Tantra- 04 seats (viii) Kayachikitsa-06 seats (ix) Panchkarma-04 seats, (x)Stri Roga -04 seats (xi) Swasthvritta-02 seats (xii) Agadtantra-04 seats (Xiii) Rachna sharir-05 seats (xiv) Rog Nidana-04 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26
2) The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2024", MESAR PG Ayurveda 2024, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder. On careful examination of the assessment report shortcomings/defects were observed:-

1. Teaching staffs:-

a) Availability of total teaching staff for UG( BAMS) Course as per the part 1 submitted by the college is Available/Required x100% = 43/45 x100% = 95.55 % (Excluding Excess)

b) Shortcoming for UG is as under-

- 3) As per the Regulation no. 04 of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda, Regulations, 2024 published on 01st October, 2024 there shall be 18 Postgraduate programs in Ayurveda on and from the date of publication of the said Regulations shalakya Tantra Postgraduate program has been divided into Shalakya- Netra Roga Chikitsa (Ayurveda Ophthalmology) & Shalakya- Karna, Naasa and Mukha Raga Chikitsa (Ayurveda Oto-Rhino Laryngology and same was informed to you vide letter Ref. No.-3/2025/MARB/General Matters dated 05.05.2025. In response of the same you have sent an email dated 27.06.2025 enclosing the letter vide ref no. PG/516/2025 dated 31.05.2025 in which for 04 seats of Shalakya Tantra you have opted for Shalakya-Netra Roga Chikitsa-02 seats and for Shalakya-Karna, Nasa & Mukha Roga Chikitsa-02 Seats .
- 4) The submission made by the college during clarification and assessment report have been carefully re-examined in terms concerned Regulation and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder and as per the direction of competent authority the assessment report along with clarification report was once again placed in the 128<sup>th</sup> Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 24.06.2025 and Board concluded that the college is fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations in 10 PG courses and not fulfilling the criteria for issuance of permission in UG ( BAMS) Course with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) due to non-availability of required teaching staff and in 04 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Rasa Shastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana- 05 seats (ii) Kaumarbhritiya-Bala Roga- 02 seats (iii) Stri Roga -04 seats (iv) Shalakya Tantra- 04 seats due to non-availability of Professor and required teaching staff as per MESAR PG Ayurveda 2024. However, Board decided to issue yearly permission as per the approved Seat Reduction Policy in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 for failing to maintain the minimum essential standards for the Academic year 2025-26 and as per the Board policy letter dated 09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025 and teacher student ratio. AS per the above decision after applying the seat Reduction Policy detail is as under-

### a) As per the seat reduction policy 2025-26:-

***For deficiency of every one teacher, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 05% of total intake capacity".***

*All the colleges shall fulfill the requirement of teaching staff as mentioned in Schedule IV of MESAR 2024 and the availability of teaching staff for 60 and 100 intake capacity shall be 100% as the provision of conditional permission mentioned in the Regulation 3(3) of MSR-2016 is not available in the MESAR-2024. However, as per the revised policy letter issued on 20.01.2025, "The 10% Relaxation in the requirement of the teaching staff may be extended for the Academic year 2025-26. Therefore, the colleges with 60 and 100 intake capacity shall have minimum of 27 and 40 teaching staff respectively fulfilling the requirements of the individual departments separately".*

After re-verification of the submitted clarification and the assessment report, college is having only 43 total eligible Teaching faculties and fulfilling the required teaching staff as per the revised Policy letter.

**For PG Course:-**

**"In case of non availability of Professor in the Post graduate department or specialty permission shall be granted as per the available teacher student ratio by reducing the intake strength in the concerned department".**

*As per sub-Regulation 2 of Regulation 19 of MESAR PG Ayurveda 2024, The Teacher student ratio shall be subject to availability of student-Postgraduate guide in the ratio of 3:1, for three students for one Professor; in case of Associate Professor 2:1 two students for one Associate Professor; and in case of Assistant Professor the ration is 1:1 one student for one Assistant Professor.*

**In department of Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-** College is having 04 eligible teaching faculty (01 Professor & 01 associate professor for UG & 02 assistant professor - 01 for UG and 01 for PG ) and there is shortcoming of 01 higher faculty for PG . Accordingly as per the available faculty, college is fulfilling the teacher student ratio as per the submitted seats in Part-1 and **eligible for issuance of permission for 05 seats.**

**In department of Kaumarbhritya-Bala Roga -** College is having 05 eligible teacher (01 associate professor for UG and 02 assistant professor -01 for UG and 01 for PG and 02 excess staff ) and there is shortcoming of 01 professor both for PG & UG . Accordingly as per the available faculty, college is fulfilling the teacher student ratio as per the submitted seats in Part-1 and **eligible for issuance of permission for 02 seats.**

**In department of Prasuti & Stri Roga -** College is having 05 eligible teacher (01 associate professor for UG and 03 assistant professor for UG & PG and 01 excess staff) and there is shortcoming of 01 professor for both UG & PG , Accordingly as per the available faculty, college is fulfilling the teacher student ratio as per the submitted seats in Part-1 and **eligible for issuance of permission for 04 seats.**

**In department of Shalakya Tantra -** College is having 05 eligible teacher (01 Professor for UG, 02 associate professor for UG AND PG & 02 assistant professor - 01 for UG and 01 for PG and there is shortcoming of 01 professor for UG& PG , Accordingly as per the available faculty, college is fulfilling the teacher student ratio as per the submitted seats in Part-1 and **eligible for issuance of permission for 04 seats ( opted for Shalakya-Netra Roga Chikitsa-02 seats and for Shalakya-Karna, Nasa & Mukha Roga Chikitsa-02 Seats).**

Accordingly, after applying the seat reduction policy 2025-26 under section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 and as per the PG Regulation 2024 , college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of yearly permission **with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 57 seats in 14 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & Siddhant- 03 seats (ii) Kriya Sharir- 04 seats (iii) Dravyaguna Vigyana- 03 seats (iv) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana- 05 seats (v) Kaumarbhritya-Bala Roga- 02 seats (vi) Shalya Tantra-07 seats (vii) Shalakya Tantra- 04 seats ( opted for Shalakya-Netra Roga Chikitsa-02 seats and for Shalakya-Karna, Nasa & Mukha Roga Chikitsa-02 Seats) (viii) Kayachikitsa-06 seats (ix) Panchkarma-04 seats, (x)Stri Roga -04 seats (xi) Swasthvritta-02 seats (xii) Agadtantra-04 seats (Xiii) Rachna sharir-05 seats (xiv) Rog Nidana-04 seats** for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.

**"DECISION"**

- 5) Therefore, in view of shortcomings and deficiencies mentioned as above Yearly Permission in accordance with Regulation 54 (3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 and as per the Policy letter dated 09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025 is hereby granted to **Tilak Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, 583/2, Rasta Peth, Pune-411011, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0141) with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 57 seats in 14 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & Siddhant- 03 seats (ii) Kriya Sharir- 04 seats (iii) Dravyaguna Vigyana- 03 seats (iv) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana- 05 seats (v) Kaumarbhritya-Bala Roga- 02 seats (vi) Shalya Tantra-07 seats (vii) Shalakya Tantra- 04 seats ( opted for Shalakya-Netra Roga Chikitsa-02 seats and for Shalakya-Karna, Nasa & Mukha Roga Chikitsa-02 Seats) (viii) Kayachikitsa-06 seats (ix) Panchkarma-04 seats, (x)Stri Roga -04 seats (xi) Swasthvritta-02 seats (xii) Agadtantra-04 seats (Xiii) Rachna sharir-05 seats (xiv) Rog Nidana-04 seats** for the academic session 2025-26, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that aforementioned shortcomings shall be fulfilled along with the following conditions:-

- I. It is further informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 seats (125 Seats including EWS)] and 15% of Postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of with 57 seats in 14 PG courses** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
- 6) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.

- 7) Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
- 8) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 9) **The aforementioned shortcomings as following requirements should be fulfilled by the college as per Regulation 55 (2) of MESAR 2024 and the compliance report shall be submitted before 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2025 to be considered for the permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-**
- All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
  - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
  - All the requirements of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda, Regulations, 2024,
  - All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
  - The remaining shortcoming mentioned in Para no. 2 , shall be fulfilled.
  - The remaining visitation fees as communicated in the letter 28.01.2025.
- 10) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.
